Subject: Terms of Reference for engaging various consultants for Project Management Unit (PMU) established in Revenue Department (DM) for effective monitoring and implementation of World Bank funded Karnataka Water Security and Resilience Program (KWSRP).

Background:

World Bank funded Karnataka Water Security and Resilience Program (KWSRP) is being implemented in the State. The overarching objective of the Karnataka Water Security and Resilience Program (KWSRP) is to enhance disaster resilience through both structural and non-structural measures. The project aims to develop climate- resilient infrastructure to effectively mitigate the impacts of floods and droughts, while simultaneously strengthening disaster risk governance and resilience mechanisms across the State. The project has a financial outlay of Rs. 5000 crore, out of which the World Bank loan will be Rs.3500 crore and the Government of Karnataka contributing Rs.1500 crore.

The program is set to be implemented over six years, starting from 2025-26, and will cover the entire state of Karnataka, with a special focus on Bengaluru. Revenue Department (DM) is the nodal agency for implementation of the project.

Constitution of PMU: A PMU is established at the Revenue Department (Disaster Management) which will have the overall responsibility of coordinating with four implementing agencies, viz, BBMP, BWSSB, Minor Irrigation & Groundwater Development Department and KSDMA, and will monitor the implementation of the Program and coordinate with implementation agencies. The PMU will include specialized technical personnel as well as

various domain experts. The PMU will develop a specific monitoring and evaluation (M&E) system to track Program achievements.

The PMU will ensure the implementation of the project is as per Program Operational Manual (POM) and Program Appraisal Document (PAD). The PMU will coordinate with Independent Verification Agency to ensure DLI (Disbursement Linked Indicators) targets are achieved as per the defined verification protocol and ensure disbursements against each DLIs. Fulfilling the aforementioned objectives places enormous responsibility on the Revenue Department (Disaster Management), the Nodal Department, for the timely and effective implementation of the KWSRP. 'Let's reiterate commitment to spread Bhupen Da's message'

Today 8th September is a very special day for all those who are passionate about Indian culture and music. It is particularly more special for my sisters and brothers of Assam. After all, it is the birth anniversary of Bhupen Hazaree, one of the most extraordinary voices India has ever known. As you are all aware, this year marks the beginning of his birth centenary celebrations. It is an occasion to revisit his monumental contributions to Indian artistic expression and public consciousness.

What Bhupen Da gave us extends far beyond music. His works embodied emotions that transcended melody. More than just a voice, he was the heartbeat of the people. Generations have grown up listening to his songs, each word resonating with themes of kindness, social justice, unity and deep-rooted belonging.

From Assam emerged a voice that flowed like a timeless river, crossing borders and cultures, carrying with it the spirit of humanity. Bhupen Da travelled the globe, rubbed shoulders with the who's who across all spectrums of society but remained deeply connected to his roots in Assam. The rich oral traditions, folk melodies and community storytelling practices of Assam deeply shaped his early childhood. These experiences formed the bedrock of his artistic vocabulary. He always carried the spirit of Assam's indigenous identity and ethos in his people's songs.

Brilliance came to Bhupen Da at a very young age. At the age of just five, he sang at a public event and quickly caught the attention of none other than Late Mahatma Gandhi. Becharah, the pioneering figure of Assamese literature. By the time he was a teenager, he had recorded his first song. But music was only one part of his personality. Bhupen Da was as much an intellectual at heart... curi-

ous, articulate and driven by an insatiable thirst for knowledge. The world cultural legends like Jyoti Prasad Agarwala and Bishnu Prasad Rabha left a deep impression on his mind and also deepened his respect for art. It was also this desire to learn that made him excel at Cotton College, Banaras Hindu University and took him to the United States, where he interacted with leading academics, thinkers and musicians of those times. He met Paul Robeson, the legendary artist and civil rights leader. Robeson's "O! Man River" became the inspiration for Bhupen Da's iconic composition "Bistrita Parore". The much-admired former American First Lady Eleanor Roosevelt awarded him a Gold Medal for his performances of Indian folk music.

Bhupen Da had the option of remaining in the US, but he returned to India and immersed himself in music. From radio to theatre, films to educational documentaries, he was well-served in each of these media. When ever he went, he emphasised supporting young talent. His works combined lyrical flair and also gave social messages, touching upon justice for the poor, rural development, strength of common citizens, to name a few. Through his music, he gave voice to the voiceless, especially the tea garden workers, women farmers, etc. In addition to being nostalgic, Bhupen Da's works also became a powerful lens to view modernity. A true artist, Bhupen Da was a powerful expression in Bhupen Hazaree's life journey. His works transcended lin-

It is gladdening that the Assam Government has supported the work of the Bhupen Hazaree Cultural Trust, which is working to popularise his life journey among youngsters.

Bhupen Hazaree's life teaches us the power of empathy, of listening to people and of staying rooted. His songs continue to be sung by young and old alike. His music teaches us to be compassionate and courageous. It asks us to remember our rivers, our labourers, our tea workers, our Nari Shakti and our Yuva Shakti. It encourages us to believe in unity in diversity.

11-year-old raped for months, her baby dies soon after birth

Bareilly: An 11-year-old girl who was allegedly raped for months by her 49-year-old neighbour, gave birth to a premature baby Saturday. The newborn died within 30 minutes of delivery at a hospital in Bareilly, police said Sunday, adding that the girl underwent an abortion last week and was found to be seven months pregnant, reports Krishna Chaudhary.

Circle officer Nilesh Mishra said, "We have taken note of the heinous matter. An FIR has been lodged under BNS

sections 62 (rape of a girl under 12 years) age 0.35 (criminal intimidation), and the Pocco Act. The accused was arrested and sent to jail." The survivor's brother founded a police complaint, a copy of which is with TOI, describing his sister's ordeal. "My sister, for the past few days, was complaining of severe stomach pain. On Thursday, I took her to a private hospital, and the doctor advised me to get an ultrasound done. After the ultrasound, the doctor said, to our shock, that my sister was over six months pregnant."

Bengal SSC holds teacher exam amid tight security

Kolkata: About 91% of 3.2 lakh enrolled candidates appeared for West Bengal SSC's School Level Selection Test (SLST) for recruitment of assistant teachers for classes 9 and 10 under tight security Sunday, reports Poulami Roy. The exam was held to fill vacancies after Supreme Court April 3 order compelling the appointment of 25,575 teachers and staff recruited through the 2016 SLST.

Tuhina Parvin Mandal, a dismissed teacher from the 2016 panel, told TOI, "We feel deprived. In 2016, I appeared for the exam and secured a

job based on my merit, but after so many years, I suddenly lost it without any fault of mine. I tried my best to concentrate, and the paper was good, but I don't know whether I will crack it this time because we had very little time to prepare."

Mumun Haldar from South 24 Parganas, a fresher, said, "As we had so much about corruption, I am a little concerned. This time, the recruitment should be based only on merit, nothing else."
